

Organ Notes

Because both of my music team colleagues are away this weekend, the music this Sunday will be more in the traditional vein. Our first hymn, *Fairest Lord Jesus*, is also known as the *Crusaders' Hymn*. However, interestingly it has nothing to do with the Crusades. The text for *Jesus the Very Thought of Thee* comes from a 12th century Latin poem that was not set to this hymn tune until 1886. Our final hymn addresses our commitment to God via Love, Light, and Joy and closes with an invocation of testimony to those attributes of the Cross. Let your singing reflect the inspiration I try to impart with varying the tonal accompaniments of each verse. If I'm playing quieter, sing more reflectively. Similarly, if I'm playing more robustly, sing with zeal! The communion organ mediation is a lovely setting of a Swedish hymn tune featuring the softer string stops of our pipe organ. The postlude is the antithesis of the communion organ solo. It is a full organ setting of the *Austrian Hymn* known to us as the familiar hymn, *Glorious Things of Thee Are Spoken*.
