Organ Notes

The traditional hymn offering today is, probably, one of the most sung hymns on this glorious day. I fondly remember singing this at a very young age when we went to church on Easter Sunday with my paternal grandmother in this huge Congregational church in Philadelphia. I was hooked on the hymn and the pipe organ ever since! This beloved Easter text began in Latin then German before reaching English by Charles Wesley in 1740. The organ postlude is not for the "faint of heart." It is a harmonically challenging piece to listen to as the arranger initially strives to represent the "strife" and suffering of Christ on the cross through considerable dissonance. The piece is in three sections: an opening fanfare with the melody appearing in double pedals, yes, both feet at the same time, a middle passacaglia with the melody in the reeds, and the final ending with the double pedaling again and full organ. Warning! The powerful dissonances continue until the final triumphant major chord, signifying the glory of Christ's resurrection.
